Summarization 2017

Option One: Self Sufficient

Tenant does not want a summarization. During splashing of their boat, the tenant <u>MUST</u> drive the boat. RVM will help, but will not drive the boat, charge batteries, test systems, etc.

Option Two: The Check-up \$140.00

Includes: Checking the fluids, checking the tires, charging the battery, starting up the boat/running engine, testing the systems and the auto bilge. Also includes splashing and tying boat up in the slip. (1 hour of labor)

Option Three: The Works \$205.00

Includes: Checking fluids, checking the tires, charging the battery, starting up the boat/running engine, testing the system, including and the auto bilge. Lake testing the boat, running at speed. Testing the systems while under way- depth finders, gauges, etc. Recording speed and RPM's for future reference. Tying the boat in its slip, covering boat if applicable, and returning the boat keys to the store. (1.5 hours of labor)

Due to several days of below freezing temperatures this winter, batteries probably did not do well if they were left in the boat.
